

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS
(6 DOMESTIC ANIMALS)**
CAUTION
ENVIRONMENTAL CAUTIONS:

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Keep out of any body of water. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from treated areas.

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on plants. Protective information may be obtained from your Agricultural Extension Service. Apply this product only as specified on this label. Keep this product in original container.

Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of waste.

Do not spray vegetable gardens or other plants used for food purposes. Keep away from fruit, food stuffs, and domestic water supplies. Keep container closed.

DO NOT USE, POUR, SPILL, OR STORE NEAR HEAT OR OPEN FLAME. Handle concentrate in a ventilated area.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner for which it is not labeled.

For control of chinch bugs, and weevils (stem weevil, grass, bark, brown bug, etc.), crickets, cutworms, earwig, grasshoppers, chiggers and sowbugs (pillbugs) infesting lawns and turfs that grow down thoroughly before starting with this emulsifiable concentrate. Dilute spray on the rate of 1 tablespoon per gallon of water to treat 100 square feet at 8 a.m./p.m. (10 tablespoons per 1/2 acre) of water and apply over 1,000 square feet area. When using a hose back-on-the-way (10-gallon) or 20-gallon sprayer, 1/2 quart per 100 square feet with spray and fields being in to top with water. Then apply the mixture over 2,000 square feet of lawn grass. The steps in one direction and allow in another direction to approximately 1,000 square feet. Repeat application if chinch bug damage persists or when stem weevil.

NOTE: To help prevent infestation of buildings for fire, cockroaches, fleas, flies, ticks, spiders, and scorpions (although, there is a limit of 8 to 10 feet wide around the building and also the building foundation to a height of 2 to 3 feet where pests are active and may find refuge. Drive spray at the same rate as above. Apply in a coarse spray to thoroughly and uniformly wet the treated area.

ORNSAMENTALS: To control aphids, lace bugs, eastern tent caterpillar, fall webworm, grasshoppers, white, lace weevils, whiteflies, chiggers and sowbugs (pillbugs) infesting ornamentals. Dilute 1 tablespoon in 1 gallon of water. To control cutworms, fall webworm, grasshoppers, earwigs, meadow katydid, and other insects: Dilute 1 ounce (2 tablespoons) in 1 gallon of water. To control ash borer: Dilute 2 ounces (4 tablespoons) in 1 gallon of water. Avoid over spraying to the root of sensitive plants.

Test when pests appear and repeat at 7 to 10-day interval if needed.

NOTE: DO NOT USE ON AZALEAS, CAMELLIAS, PANSIES, ROSES OR VANDERBILT IVY BECAUSE OF POSSIBLE INJURY TO THESE PLANTS.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
DO NOT USE, POUR, SPILL, OR STORE NEAR HEAT OR OPEN FLAME. Handle concentrate in a ventilated area.
DO NOT RE-USE EMPTY CONTAINER. Wash in soap and water.

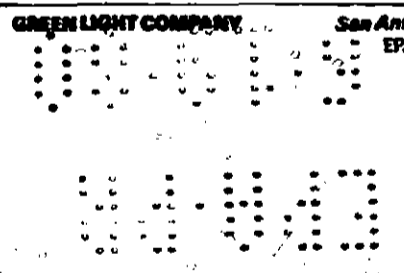
