STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED Remove victim to fresh air and apply respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN Wash promptly with soap and water. Rinse thoroughly.

IF IN EYES Rinse eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN—If signs of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine is an antidote. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE. Do not contaminate food and feed. Keep out of reach of children. Do not store near food or feed products.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in paper and put in trash collection.

FIRE ANTS: To aid in the control of fire ants in lawns and other recreational areas, apply 1/2 cup over, and 6 foot around, each fire ant mound. Immediately after application, water in thoroughly. A minimum of 1 gallon of water should be applied to each mound area. Reapply as necessary. Apply gently to avoid disturbing ants. Use of high pressure watering equipment may disturb the ants and cause migration, reducing product effectiveness.

NOTE For best results, apply in cool weather, 65 to 80 F or in early morning or late evening hours. Treat new mounds as they appear.
