Your amended application of October 17, 1995

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the following changes and submit one (1) copy to us before your ship product:

1. After "CAUTION", revise text as follows:

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through the skin, or inhaled. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Avoid inhalation of dust. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash thoroughly before reuse.

2. Change "Statement of Practical Treatment" to "FIRST AID" and change the "IF SWALLOWED" text as follows:

FIRST AID

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

3. Change the ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS section to read:

This product is extremely toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Runoff and drift from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in adjacent sites. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

- 4. Revise the beginning of your use directions-as follows:

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR USE ON HOME ORNAMENTAL GARDENS ONLY:

- 5. Place the "Storage and Disposal" statements after the use directions and revise as follows:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store only in original container, in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap securely in newspaper and discard in trash.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

FOR USE ON ORNAMENTALS: Apply this product when infestation first appears. Apply at a

rate of 1/2 to 2/3 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. Reapply as necessary.

ORNAMENTALS: Apply thoroughly as needed for control of the following insects:

Aphids---Aster, Gladiolus, Iris, Rose, Sunflower, Sweet Peas.

Cabbage Looper and Imported Cabbageworm---Carnation, Chrysanthemum, Dahlia, Daisy, Rose, Sweet Peas, Zinnia.

Flea Beetle---Petunia, Primrose, Sunflower, Violet, Wallflower.

Japanese Beetle---Rose

FLEAS ON DOGS AND CATS: Dust animal thoroughly and rub into fur. Repeat weekly as required for control. Do not allow product to get into eyes, nose or ears of animals. Do not use on puppies or kittens less than 4 weeks old.

FLEAS IN KENNELS, PENS, LAWNS, AND UNDER HOUSES: Apply 5 to 10 ounces per 250 sq. ft. Remove debris before dusting.

LICE ON HORSES: Apply 1 to 4 ounces of powder depending on the size of the animal. Work into hair. Repeat in 10 to 12 days and as needed thereafter.
