Under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, registration of this pesticide is required under EPA Reg. No. 869-TX-1.

#### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

**IF SWALLOWED:** Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention.

**IF ON SKIN:** In case of contact, remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash skin with plenty of soap and water.

**IN IN EYES:** Flush eyes with plenty of water.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Chloropyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat Symptomatically. Atropine only by injection is an antidote.

#### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

##### HAZARDS TO HUMANS (AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS)

##### CAUTION

Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Keep away from food, feedstuffs and domestic water supplies. Wash thoroughly after handling.

##### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on plants. Protective information may be obtained from your Cooperative Agricultural Extension service.

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as listed on this label.

## PESTS INDOORS

**GENERAL INFORMATION:** Use Green Light Indoor Flea & Tick Spray to control the pests indicated in the areas listed below by application of the product as an undiluted spray (0.5% chlorpyrifos). Repeat the treatment as needed.

Do not apply sprays of this product in conduits, motor housing, junction and switch boxes or other electrical equipment because of possible shock hazard. Do not use in poultry houses or other animal buildings. Do not allow spray to contact food, feedstuffs and water supplies. Thoroughly wash dishes and food handling utensils with soap and water if they become contaminated by application of this product. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried. Remove pets and cover fish bowls (tanks) before spraying.

**APPLICATION WITHIN RESIDENTIAL BUILDING INCLUDING HOMES AND APARTMENT BUILDINGS AND WITHIN NONFOOD AREAS OF INDUSTRIAL, INSTITUTIONAL, AND COMMERCIAL BUILDING INCLUDING HOSPITALS, STORES, MANUFACTURING PLANTS AND WAREHOUSES: FOR SPOT TREATMENT ONLY -** Apply as a coarse spray or with a paint brush to localized areas where COCKROACHES, (including strains resistant to certain other insecticides), ANTS, CLOVER MITES, CRICKETS, FIREBRATS, SILVERFISH, AND SPIDERS are found or normally occur including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along and behind baseboards; beneath and behind sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets; around plumbing and other utility installations. For ants apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and where ever else these pests may find entrance. **NOTE:** A period of 4 to 7 days is normally required for maximum effect on cockroaches.

**FOR CONTROL OF FLEAS AND TICKS,** thoroughly apply as a spray for spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters; near-by cracks and crevices; along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment of pet area. **DO NOT TREAT PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT.** To control the source of flea infestation pets inhabiting the treated premises should be treated with a product registered for application to animals.

## PESTS OUT-OF-DOORS

**FLIES, MOSQUITOES:** For outdoor use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames of wherever these insects may enter the room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures on porches, in garages, and other places where these insects alight or congregate. Repeat as necessary.

**ANTS, FLEAS, TICKS, CRICKETS AND EARWIGS:** For treatment of localized infestations of these insects in outdoor areas where there are weeds or brushy non-crop areas, spray infested areas thoroughly. For ants, thoroughly wet hills and runways. Repeat applications as infestations warrant or as reinfestations occur.
