STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. If possible vomiting should be induced under medical supervision. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger.

*Solvent presents an aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area with soap and water. Wash clothing before re-use.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Get medical attention.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine Sulfate, only by injection is an antidote.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. May be absorbed through the skin. Do not breathe spray mist. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or clothing. Wash thoroughly after using and before eating or smoking. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Keep children and pets off treated areas until spray has dried. Do not use this product in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on plants. PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame. Handle concentrate in a ventilated area.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water food or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Store product in its original labeled container in a cool, dry, locked place out of reach of children. **DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Select a suitable hand Pressure or Trigger sprayer which will deliver a coarse spray droplet. Apply to control the pests indicated in the areas listed below.

Do not apply in conduits, motor housings, junction and switch boxes or other electrical equipment because of possible shock hazard. Do not use in poultry houses, or other animal buildings. Do not allow spray to contact food, feedstuffs, and water supplies. Thoroughly wash dishes and food handling utensils with soap and water if they become contaminated by application of this product. Remove pets & cover fish bowls (tanks) before spraying. Do not apply to asphaltic tile or surfaces, rugs or carpeting nor to plants.

EASY TO MIX

Dilute 1 pint of this product in 1 gallon of water. Apply and repeat as needed for lasting control of Roaches, Fleas, Ants & other listed insects. For 1 Quart Hand Trigger Sprayers mix 4 ounces (8 tbs) per quart of water.

WHERE TO USE

APPLY WITHIN RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS INCLUDING HOMES AND APARTMENT BUILDINGS & WITHIN NON-FOOD AREAS OF INDUSTRIAL, INSTITUTIONAL & COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS, INCLUDING HOSPITALS, STORES, MANUFACTURING PLANTS, & WAREHOUSES.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT ONLY

Apply 1 pint Roach and Flea Concentrate in 1 gallon of water as a coarse spray to localized areas where COCKROACHES (including strains resistant to certain other insecticides) and ANTS are found or normally occur, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along and behind baseboards; beneath and behind sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets; around plumbing and other utility installations. NOTE: A period of 4 to 7 days is normally required for maximum effect on Cockroaches.

FOR ANTS apply to ant trails and around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (Cont.)

FOR CONTROL OF FLEAS

Thoroughly apply 1 pint Roach and Flea Concentrate in 1 gallon of water as a spray for spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters; nearby cracks and crevices; along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor where these pests may be present. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. DO NOT TREAT PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT. To control the source of your Flea infestations, treat your pets with a product registered for application to animals.

PREMISE, PORCH AND PATIO SPRAY

For the control of pests that may invade the home, such as ANTS, EARWIGS, CRICKETS, SOWBUGS, MILLIPEDS, and FLEAS mix 1 pint in 1 gallon of water and apply to cover a 850 sq.ft. of the outside areas of foundations, (for foundations treat a band 5 feet wide around the structure.) on porch and patio floors, & entrances, decking and adjacent soil surfaces. Treat beneath porches and other crawl spaces if accessible. Repeat as needed for control. Do not apply to asphaltic surfaces, rugs or carpeting nor to plants or turf areas. Keep children and pets out of treated area until the spray has dried.

IMPORTED FIRE ANT MOUND TREATMENT

As an aid in the control of the IMPORTED FIRE ANT around the outside of the home mix 1 pint in 1 gallon of water. Gently sprinkle 1 gallon of the mixture on the center and perimeter of the mound. Apply in cool weather or in early morning or late afternoon. Treat new mounds as they appear. Do not use a pressure spray since this will disturb colony and encourage ant migration.
