FOR CONTROL OF FLEAS

Thoroughly apply 1 pint Roach and Flea Concentrate in 1 gallon of water as a spray for spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters; nearby cracks and crevices; along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor where these pests may be present.
