PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Keep out of reach of children. May be harmful if swallowed. Do not take internally. Avoid eye contact. Flush contaminated eyes with plenty of water, and get medical attention if irritation persists. Wash thoroughly after handling. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: IF SWALLOWED, drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention. IF ON SKIN, in case of contact, remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash skin with plenty of soap and water. IF IN EYES, flush with plenty of water.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Active ingredient is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine only by injection.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Store in a locked storage area out of reach of children and domestic animals. Store in original container. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse container. Discard in trash.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

Apply Green Light Dursban 5% Granules uniformly to home lawns, flower beds, under shrubbery, and other ornamental and recreational turf grass areas using any hand fertilizer spreader or power operated gravity or rotary type spreader designed for application of granular materials. Treat when insects first appear using Granules at the rate of 1/2 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. or 8 lbs. per 16,000 sq. ft.

To help obtain uniform distribution, apply 1/2 required amount of product in one direction, then apply the balance at a right angle. Immediately after application sprinkle the turf with 30 gallons of water per 1,000 sq. ft. to wash the granules into the zone of insect infestation. Retreat as necessary.

**NOTE:** See directions on fertilizer or granule spreader for setting to apply.

To control certain white grubs (larvae of European chafer and Japanese beetle) use two to four times the amounts of Granules indicated, i.e. 1 to 2 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. Apply the granules uniformly over the area treated followed immediately by thorough watering to wash the insecticide in the turf. For best results treat when grubs are young and actively feeding near the soil surface, usually during late July and August. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service specialist for proper time to treat in your area.

**PERIMETER TREATMENT:** To prevent infestation of buildings by Ants, Crickets, Earwigs, and Sowbugs (Pillbugs), treat a band 6 to 10 feet wide around and adjacent to the buildings where pests are active and may find entrance. Follow same rates as indicated above for the pests to be controlled.

Keep children and pets off treated areas until material is washed into soil and grass is dry. Keep away from food, feedstuffs, and domestic water supplies.

For individual fire ant mounds, apply Green Light Dursban 5% Granules at the rate of 4 tablespoons per mound. Spread granules evenly over top of mound. Apply gently to avoid disturbing ants. For best results, apply in cool weather, 65 F to 80 F, or in early morning or late evening hours. Treat new mounds as they appear.
