HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Further, drugs like 2-PAM (pyridine-2-aldoxime methiodide) are not recommended. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is extremely toxic to aquatic and estuarine invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water and wetlands. Do not contaminate water by cleaning equipment or disposal of wastes.

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

LAWNS, RECREATIONAL AND ORNAMENTAL TURF AREAS: For control of turfgrass pests, apply granules uniformly to the turf grass. Follow specific directions for proper watering or irrigation after application.

BARRIER PEST CONTROL AROUND BUILDINGS AND IN FLOWERBEDS AND ORNAMENTAL PLANTINGS: For residual control of ants, brown dog ticks, carpenter ants, centipedes, ~~cockroaches,~~ crickets, earwigs, firebrats and silverfish, fleas, millipedes, scorpions and spiders; apply granules at the rate of 4.8 ounces per 120 square feet (6 X 20 foot band). Restrict applications to shrub beds, foundation, plantings, and lawn or soil areas immediately adjacent to the building. Lightly water treated area soon after application.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: STORAGE--Store unused product in original container only, in cool, dry area out of reach of children and animals. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL--Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. CONTAINER DISPOSAL--Do not reuse bag. Discard bag in trash.

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
