

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. Keep people and pets out of the area during application. Do not allow people or pets to enter treated areas until sprays have dried.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in original container in a locked storage area inaccessible to children or pets. Do not store near food or feedstuffs. Keep tightly closed when not using. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** If empty, do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. GENERAL INFORMATION

Green Light MSMA Crabgrass Killer₂ is useful for selective post-emergent weed control, particularly for grassy weeds. It is a combination of herbicide and surfactant. It is unnecessary to add surfactant to the spray solution. Best results are obtained on young, actively growing weeds at air temperatures between 70°F and 90°F. Avoid applications in direct sun, especially when temperatures are above 90°F as leaf burn will occur on desirable grasses. Do not water treated area for 24 hours after application. Do not spray or allow drift unto vegetables, ornamentals, or other desirable plants. Do not reseed until 2 weeks after last application.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

This product is completely water-soluble. Fill the spray tank about half full with water and add the required amount of herbicide with agitation. Finish filling the tank with water and apply. After use, clean equipment thoroughly by flushing with water. Do not store spray solution in tank for a prolonged period. Although this product is only moderately corrosive, do not use in galvanized or aluminum equipment. Do not contaminate waters used for domestic consumption, or by animals, wildlife and aquatic life, or for irrigation purposes. Do not feed foliage to livestock or graze treated areas.

LAWN AND ORNAMENTAL TURF: Do not apply with hose-end applicators. Keep children and pets off treated areas until the spray has dried.

This product is useful for control of Crabgrass, Bahiagrass, Barnyardgrass, Chickweed, Dallisgrass, Sandbur (Grassbur), Johnsongrass, Ragweed and certain other weeds with little or no injury to well-established, healthy Bermuda and Zoysia lawn grasses. Injury may occur to Bluegrass and Fescue. Exercise care when applying Green Light MSMA Crabgrass Killer₂ to these grasses, especially during stress conditions caused by heat, drought, insects, and disease activity. Do not use on Centipede or St. Augustine grasses as they will be severely damaged or killed by a Green Light MSMA Crabgrass Killer2 application. Temporary discoloration may occur after application to Bermuda or Zoysia. If this happens, water lawn thoroughly and discontinue any further applications until grass has recovered. On new lawns, do not treat until after three mowings. Mow lawn 1 to 1½ inches high 3 to 4 days before treatment. Mix 11/3 fluid ounces (8 teaspoons) of Green Light MSMA Crabgrass Killer2 in 21/2 gallons of water and apply to an area of 1,000 sq. ft. (3 teaspoons of product in 1 gallon of water applied to an area of 375 sq. ft.) Spray thoroughly to wet all undesirable plants. Repeat applications, 10 to 14 days apart, may be needed for good control. During periods of hot, dry weather water lawn thoroughly 1 or 2 days before spraying to insure weeds are growing and able to absorb the herbicide. Make applications only in early morning or late afternoon to minimize leaf burn of desirable grasses.
