If in Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

If on Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**HOUSEHOLD APPLICATION:** Remove all lower drawers in kitchen and bath, and scatter liberally in drawer wells. Spread 1/2 teaspoon in each corner of shelves. Use under cabinets, bookcases, dressers, behind range, dishwasher, refrigerator, washer and dryer. Also use in closets, garage and around window sills and door jams.

**STORAGE:** Store only in original container, in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Securely wrap in newspaper and discard in trash.
