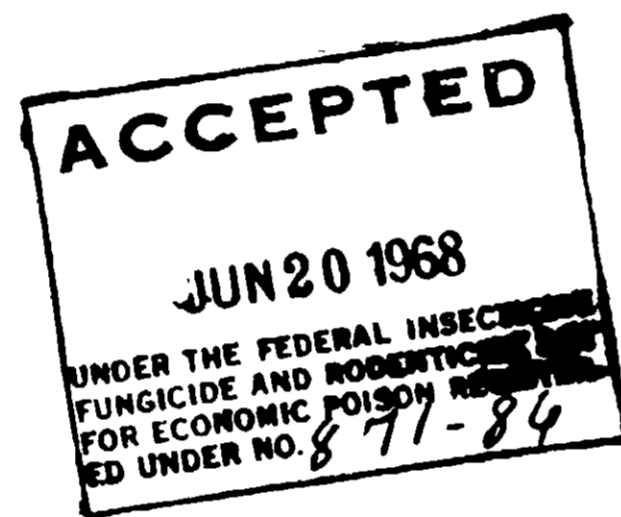

Fisons MCPP Selective Weed Killer is formulated especially for use on fine turf grasses where control of chickweed, common and mouse ear, daisy, and knotweed has heretofore been difficult to accomplish without injury to bent grasses, bluegrasses, and fescues. Because of its safety features, it is slow acting; full effects from treatment are not visible for about three weeks.

When to apply: Treat when good growing conditions prevail, preferably before weeds are too well established. Apply between mowings when maximum foliage is present.

Do not apply during periods of drought, heavy rainfall, or hot humid weather. Do not use on newly seeded turf or until desirable grasses are established. **How to apply:** Mix with water at the recommended application rates and apply with a sprayer that delivers a fine spray. Treat uniformly but not to the point of run off.

Protect from freezing. If allowed to freeze, re mix before using.

RECOMMENDED APPLICATION RATES

GOLF GREENS: 1 1/2 fluid ounces per 1,000 sq. ft. in 2 gallons of water
(4 pints per acre in 30-40 gallons of water)

FAIRWAYS, ESTABLISHED TURF: 2 fluid ounces per 1,000 sq. ft. in 2 gallons of water
(5 1/2 to 6 pints per acre)
