### CLEANING AND SANITIZING

1. Flush surfaces or equipment with water to

### SANITIZING

For glasses, utensils, food processing parts and food preparation areas.

1. Scrape and pre-flush utensils and equipment.
2. Wash with appropriate Diversey Wyandot
3. Rinse with clean water.
4. Sanitize in a DIVERSOL CX with Arodyne in 3 1/2 gallons of water providing 100 ppm sanitizer with a chlorine test kit. In the absence or if the sanitizer falls below 50 ppm available and use a starting concentration of 2x. Immerse all utensils and service ware for contact times specified by governing sanitization.
