DAIRY FARMS AND DAIRY PLANTS	After cleaning and just prior to use, sanitize equipment by spraying, circulating or immersing in a 200 ppm available chlorine solution prepared by adding 4 fl. oz. (½ cup) Diversol CX--Liquid to each 10 gallons of water used.
TOILET BOWLS	Pour in ½ cup Diversol CX--Liquid and scrub well. Let stand 10 minutes. Flush. NOTE: Do not use with other chemicals.
SINKS, BATH TUBS, PORCELAIN AND ALL WASHABLE SURFACES IN KITCHEN AND BATH ROOM	Wash thoroughly. Use 1 tablespoon Diversol CX -- Liquid for each quart of water. Keep surface wet with solution for 2 minutes. Rinse.
GARBAGE CANS, CUPS, TEAPOTS AND STAINED DISHES	Wash thoroughly, rinse and soak for 5 minutes in solution made of 1 teaspoon Diversol CX -- Liquid for each quart of water. Rinse. NOTE: Do not use on Silverware.
