This is in response to the subject amendment. The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable, subject to the comment listed below. Five (5) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted.

- Under Statement of Practical Treatment (First Aid), add the phrase "For skin wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists." Also, under the phrase "If swallowed," delete the phrase "Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available . . .," leaving the phrase to read "If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of water. Do not induce vomiting. Avoid alcohol. Get medical attention."

- 2. Rinse with clean water
- 3. Wash with recommended Diversy Wyandotte product

- 5. Air dry or blot from dust and dirt
- 6. Sanitize immediately before re use with Dividend solution prepared by diluting 1 fluid ounce of Dividend in 2 gallons of 25% solution of water for immersion brushing or circulation of sanitizer. For surface through the spray application dilute 2 ounces of Dividend in 2 gallons of water if 1% solution.
- 7. Test for activity. If an solution deprecates discard.
