Under the Statement of Practical Treatment, add the phrase "For skin, wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists." Also, under the phrase "If swallowed," delete the phrase "Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available....", leaving the phrase to read "If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of water. Do not induce vomiting. Avoid alcohol. Get medical attention."

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SANITIZER FOR Dairy, Beverage, Food Processing Equipment (Farm Tanks, Pails, Strainers, Milking Machine Parts, etc.)

- A. Clean equipment immediately after use.
 - 1. Rinse with clean water.
 - 2. Wash with recommended Diversey product.
 - 3. Rinse with clean water.
 - 4. Air dry. Protect from dust and dirt.
- B. Sanitize immediately before reuse with Dividend solution prepared by diluting 1 fl. oz. Dividend in 2 gal. (1:256 dilution) water for immersion, brushing or circulation of sanitizer. Wet surface thoroughly. For spray application, dilute 2 oz. Dividend in 2 gal. water (1:128 dilution) and apply with a coarse droplet spray to thoroughly wet surface.

Test periodically. When solution depreciates or becomes visually dirty, discard.

CONTACT TIME: The laws of some states require that utensils and equipment remain in contact with sanitizing solution for 2 minutes. Dividend fulfills the criteria of the Grade "A" Pasteurized Milk Ordinance 1978 Recommendations of the United States Public Health Service when tested by the method outlined by A.O.A.C. Germicidal Detergent and Sanitizer Test Method.
