Your Amendment Dated July 15, 1991

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five (5) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

- 1. Change the ingestion statement to read as follows:

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of water. Do not induce vomiting. Avoid alcohol. Get medical attention.

Also, you must submit a revised Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF). A blank form is enclosed. The upper and lower limits of your active ingredient, iodine, should be expressed in the form of titratable iodine (1.75%). This revision is necessary so that the CSF and label claims agree.
