Accord fulfills the criteria of Appendix of the Grade "A" Pasteurized Milk Ordinance 1965 Recommendations of the USPHS in water up to 500 ppm of hardness calculated as CaCO₃ when tested by the AOAC Germicidal and Detergent Sanitizers — Official Method.

Solutions of Accord must be made with water under 120°F. Yellow color indicates presence of titratable iodine. When color fades, renew solutions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its label.

Accord is designed for cleaning, sanitizing, or disinfecting food preparation utensils and equipment in hospitals, nursing homes, restaurants, and food service operations.

Sanitizing rinse for Glasses, Dish and Utensils.

1. Scrape and pre-rinse articles to be used.
2. Wash with recommended Diversey, Dettol, or other hand dishwashing detergent.
3. Rinse with potable water.
4. Sanitize in Accord germicide solution, taking one ounce of Accord in 10 gallons of water (provides 12 1/2 ppm titratable iodine). Immerse all articles for at least 60 seconds or for contact time specified by sanitation regulations. Test solution daily with iodine test kit and when deprecates below 12.5 ppm titratable iodine it should be discarded.
5. Air-dry on clean drain board.

Sanitizing Manually Cleaned Food Equipment and Stainless Steel Surface.

1. Rinse equipment thoroughly with water, immediately after use. Drain.
2. Wash equipment using a recommended Diversey Wyandotte cleaner accord to directions. Rinse thoroughly with water. Drain.
