**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS.  
HAZARDS TO HUMANS OR DOMESTIC ANIMALS.**

**DANGER: CORROSIVE.

Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** This pesticide is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams, and ponds. Treated effluent should not be discharged into lakes, streams, ponds, or public waters unless in accordance with NPDES permit. For guidance consult the regional office of the EPA.

**PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS. STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT:** Use only clean, dry utensils and mix only with water. Mixing with other chemicals or gross filth (feces, urine, etc.) will start a chemical reaction resulting in the release of toxic gas, heat, and possible fire. If water or moisture enters the product container, harmful or irritating chlorine-containing gases will slowly be released by decomposition.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Keep this product dry in a tightly closed container, when not in use. Store in a cool dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flames. Do not allow water to get into container. In case of decomposition, isolate container (if possible) and flood area with large amounts of water to dissolve all materials. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label directions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage and disposal, or cleaning of equipment.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL**

Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping the sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into appropriate equipment. Dispose of the liner in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by State or local authorities. Rinse empty fiber drum with water and dispose of in the same manner.
