FIRST AID

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Liquid Bacteriostatic Softener F-501 is designed for use in commercial laundry operations. Mix stored product before use.

Add 5 ounces **Liquid Bacteriostatic Softener F-501** per 100 pounds of dry laundry in the final rinse cycle. Fabric treated as directed will develop residual self-sanitizing activity against odor-causing Gram positive and Gram negative organisms under conditions of high relative humidity or wet contamination.

Liquid Bacteriostatic Softener F-501 inhibits the growth of ammonia producing organisms which act on urine in diapers to produce ammonia. **Liquid Bacteriostatic Softener F-501** softens cloths, thus eliminating chafing, "Static Cling" out of nylons and other synthetics. Improves ironing time.
