

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT. Mix only with water. Product must be diluted in accordance with label directions for use. Do not contaminate with cleaners or sanitizers as rapid decomposition of product with release of oxygen can occur which may initiate combustion.

Dispense directly from the original container. Use only dispensing equipment made of teflon, polyethylene or suitable plastics. Do not use rubber hoses or metal pumping or sampling equipment. If concentrated product must be transferred, use only a clean, dry container made of polyethylene or suitable plastics.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SANITIZING OF FOOD CONTACT SURFACES

For use in circulation cleaning and sanitizing of closed tanks, pipelines, evaporators, filters, and processing vats in dairy, carbonated beverage, wineries, breweries, bottledwater, juice, and food processing plants.

A. Clean equipment immediately after use

1. Rinse with clean water to remove soil.
2. Wash with recommended Diversy product.
3. Rinse with potable water until equipment is cooled to less than 100°F.

B. Sanitize by metering Divosan Forte directly from the original product container into a makeup tank by use of a Diversy automatic dispensing system. Dilute 1 fluid ounce of Divosan Forte in 5.6 gallons of water providing 200 ppm peroxyacetic acid. Circulate the sanitizer for at least two minutes to thoroughly contact all surfaces. Drain sanitized surfaces completely before restarting processing.

Use a Divosan Forte Test Kit to check concentration of sanitizer solution. Fresh sanitizing solution should be prepared at least daily or more often if the solution becomes diluted or soiled. Use solution may not be re-used for sanitizing. Discharge solution to waste after use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container tightly closed. Do not store at elevated temperatures or in direct sunlight. Store only in original container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous and/or toxic, and improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. 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
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
