Add 2.5 ounces of Issue Plus II per 100 pounds of dry fabric to the sour cycle of a commercial washer using a normal 6 inch water (Low) setting. Run the operation for at least 6 minutes for uniform treatment of fabric. (Note: 2.5 ounces of dry Issue Plus II by weight is equal to 3.5 ounces by volume.)

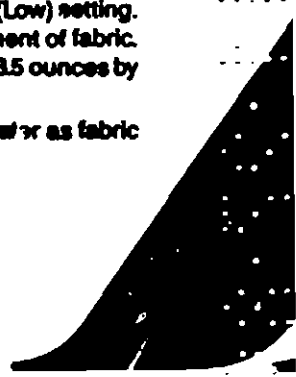
