Add 2.5 ounces of **Issue Plus II** per 100 pounds of dry fabric to the sour cycle of a commercial washer using a normal 6 inch water (low) setting. Run the operation for at least 6 minutes for uniform treatment of fabric. (Note: 2.5 ounces of dry **Issue Plus II** by weight is equal to 3.5 ounces by volume) Do not use **Issue Plus II** where high iron levels occur in water as fabric discoloration may occur.
