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DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR INDOORS USE ONLY

For Roaches, Silverfish. Use a coarse wet spray that will not float in the air. Direct spray in such a manner as to penetrate all cracks, crevices and other hiding places. Contact directly as many insects as possible. Wet thoroughly around shelves, under sinks, refrigeration equipment, dishwashing machines and bottle washers. Treat all returned bottle cartons and cases. For badly infested areas, spray **D-Sect B-20** daily.

During the summer months, spraying twice a week is advisable.

For Flies, Mosquitoes and Gnats. Close room and turn off air conditioning or ventilation systems before fogging. Remove exposed food. Cover food handling equipment to prevent contamination from spray. For best results in large areas, disperse with an electric sprayer, although hand or compressed air sprayers may be used. Direct spray toward the ceiling and continue spraying until area is thoroughly fogged. Leave room closed for at least 15 minutes after spraying. Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Remove and destroy dead insects. Repeat **D-Sect B-20** application as often as necessary.

For Bed Bugs, Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks in buildings. Spray lower wall portions, baseboards, bedding, rugs, carpets and floors of infested areas. Animal quarters, kennels and bedding should also be sprayed. Contact directly as many insects as possible. Repeat at least once a week or when reinfestation becomes evident.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.
