

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

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Control complies with 21 CFR 178.1010, Sanitizing Solutions Food Additive Law for final sanitizing rinsing of food processing equipment and on food contact surfaces in bars and restaurants. No rinse required in dairies unless specified by area health auth. rules. This product fulfills the criteria of Appendix F of the Grade A Pasteurized Milk Ordinance 1978 Recommendations of the U.S. Public Health Service in waters up to 750 ppm of hardness calculated as CaCO3 when tested by the AOAC Germicidal and Detergent Sanitizers Official Method.

Control is authorized by USDA for use in Federally inspected meat and poultry plants.

**For Final Sanitizing Rinsing in Food Plant
For Sanitizing Equipment in Meat and Poultry Plants**

- For sanitizing utensils and equipment in hand wash, soak, and spray operations:
1. Pre-flush or pre-scrape utensils and glasses to remove gross food particles. Pre-Soak if necessary.
 2. Wash thoroughly with a Diversey detergent.
 3. Rinse with potable water.
 4. Sanitize in a solution of 200 ppm Quaternary (1/4 ounce per 1 gallon of water). Immerse all utensils and glasses for at least 2 minutes. If spraying, make sure surface stays wet with sanitizer for at least 2 minutes.
 5. Place sanitized utensils on a rack to air dry. Allow all surfaces to drain adequately before contact with food.

For hand wash operations, fresh sanitizing solution must be prepared at least daily, prepare it more often if the solution becomes diluted or soiled.

Solution used in spray operations may not be re-used for sanitizing. Only one sanitization per solution is allowed. The solution may be used for cleaning or other purposes if it is not soiled.

For Disinfecting in Hospitals and Rest Homes: Clean equipment with a suitable detergent and rinse. For disinfecting hard surfaces such as floors, walls, furnishings and carts use 3/4 ounces of Control per 1 gallon of water (600 ppm Quat). For disinfecting porous surfaces use 1 1/2 ounces of Control per 1 gallon of water (1200 ppm Quat).

APPLICATIONS: After cleaning surfaces with suitable detergent and rinsing, the sanitizing solution of Control may be applied by soaking, spraying with suitable spray equipment, a clean mop or clean sponge.
