The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

1. Add the statement "Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying." to the Precautionary Statements.
2. In the Ingredients Statement, revise the declaration of the active ingredient "Pyrethrins I and II" to read "Pyrethrins".
3. Delete the ":" after the signal word CAUTION on the front panel and in the Precautionary Statements.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Submit three copies of final printed labeling prior to releasing product for shipment.

The confidential statement of formula referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

1. Revise Box 10 for the active ingredient d-trans Allethrin. The source of the active ingredient is 90 percent active, not 50 percent active.
2. Revise Box 13.b. for the solvent to read "98.38" rather than "78.38".
3. The confidential statement of formula for the basic formulation (dated May 8, 1996) supercedes all previously submitted confidential statements of formula for the basic formulation.

**Super Brand Insecticide**

Super Brand Insecticide kills flies, mosquitoes, roaches, waterbugs, fleas, silverfish, and spiders that are contacted by the product.

Noncorrosive and nondestructive to equipment, machinery and utensils. Modern insect control requires regular treatment and good housekeeping.

For use in Meat Packing Plants, Bakeries, Food Processing Plants, Warehouses, Boxcar, Poultry Plants, Restaurants, Super Markets, Bottling Plants, milk handling areas of milk, cheese, and ice cream plants wherever food products are made, stored, shipped or handled. Recommended for use in Hotels, Motels, Institutions, Theaters, Hospitals, Transportation Facilities, Trains, Buses, Planes.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use the product in food processing plants only when plant is not in operation. Food should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered or thoroughly cleaned with an effective cleaning compound followed by a rinse with potable water prior to reuse. Do not spray on food. Thoroughly ventilate treated area before re-entry.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

- Flies and Mosquitoes:** Close doors and windows. Direct spray towards ceiling and fill entire room with fog. Keep room closed for 10 to 20 minutes. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat treatment as frequently as required.
- Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Silverfish:** Thorough and repeated spraying of the infested area should be done, hitting as many of the insects as possible. Pay particular attention to spraying in cracks, crevices, baseboards, and other hiding places.
- Fleas Infesting Premises:** Can be controlled quickly and effectively by spraying floors and cracks of the infested areas. Fleas lurk in carpets and upholstered furniture. Spray liberally in these areas, as well as in baseboards, wall cracks and sleeping quarters of animals for direct contact with these pests.
- Spiders:** Spray directly into or on spider webs with as wet a spray as possible. Also spray directly on all visible spiders with a wet spray.

**NOTE:** In hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Ventilate room for 2 hours prior to returning.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:**

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

**PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Store in original container away from heat or open flame.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or recycle and disposal in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by State and local authorities.
