

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use only in non-residential food handling areas of food plants, meat, poultry and egg processing plants, bakeries, dairies, milking parlors, canneries, restaurants, cafeterias, grocery stores, packaged food storage warehouses, and bagged or bulk grain storage facilities.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, WASPS, FRUIT FLIES, AND SMALL FLYING MOTHS: Determine cubic feet of space to be treated. Install units near the ceiling with each unit covering not more than 50,000 cubic feet of space. Electrically wire units so that all units controlled by one timer will activate simultaneously. Application concentration is 1.5 grams of product per 1000 cubic feet of space. Units deliver an average flow rate of 4.0 grams per second at 72°F. Activate each unit for 19 seconds to treat 50,000 cubic feet. Do not remain in treated area. Keep area closed for at least 30 minutes. Ventilate area before re-entry. Set timer to activate units on desired frequency schedule. Sweep up and destroy fallen

insects periodically.

STORED PRODUCT INSECTS (accessible stages), INCLUDING INDIAN MEAL (CHOCOLATE) MOTHS, ANGOUMOIS GRAIN MOTHS AND FLYING MEDITERANEAN FLOUR MOTHS. Activate each unit for 19 seconds to treat 50,000 cubic feet. Set timer to activate units on desired frequency schedule. Infested stored food products should be fumigated or treated with an approved product.

MANUAL APPLICATION AS CONTACT AND SPACE SPRAY TO CONTROL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, WASPS, FRUIT FLIES AND SMALL FLYING MOTHS: Close doors and windows and shut off ventilation systems. Application concentration is 1.5 grams of product per 1000 cubic feet of space. Apply product with appropriate, high pressure, hand held, spray device. Direct spray into all cracks and crevices, behind all equipment, obstructions, and dark harborages to provide maximum penetration and impingement on insects. Then apply as a space spray, directing the spray toward the ceiling and upper corners of the area. Vacate the treated area and keep closed for at least one hour. Ventilate before reoccupying. Repeat treatment if necessary.
