DIRECTIONS:

For use on lawns and ornamental turf grass for control of clover, chickweed* (common, mouseear, and perennial or stitchwort), curly dock, dog fennel, knotweed, and sheep sorrel, apply 1 pound of BANVEL Chickweed-Clover Killer per 500 sq. ft.
