POST CONSTRUCTION TREATMENTS

Application of H-72 in 71 gallons of water to produce a 2.5% water emulsion for subterranean termites and for *Cryptotermes* spp. applications shall be made by soil slat, rod hole, or low pressure spray.

Application of the emulsion until location of heat or air conditioning ducts, vents, and power (or plumbing) lines are known and identified. Extreme caution should be taken to avoid contamination of these structural elements and airways.

Apply a broadcast application of this product in a crawl space. Do not apply the product to the soil beneath a plenum air space.

Apply injections of the emulsion into wood elements of construction.

SLAB-ON-GROUND

Apply emulsion at the rate of 4 gallons per 10 linear feet. Application shall be made by in-slab injection, trenching or horizontal rodding.

Apply emulsion from grade to the top of the footing along the outside and, where applicable, along the inside of the foundation perimeter. Treatment may also be made along one side of a partition wall (especially where the walls connect to the floor by fixtures inserted in the slab) and along cracks, expansion joints and other critical areas.

Apply emulsion should be spaced in a manner that will allow for application of a continuous chemical barrier.

When necessary, drill through the foundation walls from the outside and apply emulsion just beneath the slab or along the inside of the foundation.

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Application of the emulsion until location of heat or air conditioning ducts, vents, and power (or plumbing) lines are known and identified. Extreme caution should be taken to avoid contamination of these structural elements and airways.

Apply a broadcast application of this product in a crawl space. Do not apply the product to the soil beneath a plenum air space. Apply injections of the emulsion into wood elements of construction.

Hollow Masonry Units of the Foundation and or Basement Wall (below grade)

Treat soil as to make a continuous chemical barrier in the voids. Apply the emulsion at the rate of 2 gallons per 10 linear feet. Apply the emulsion so it will reach the footing.

CRAWL SPACES

Apply the emulsion at the rate of 4 gallons per 10 linear feet per foot of depth from the grade to the top of the footing. For example, a footing 3 feet deep would require 12 gallons of emulsion per 10 linear feet. Application must be made by rodding and or trenching.

Treat both sides of foundation and around all piers and pipes.

When rodding from grade or from the bottom of a shallow trench, rod holes should be spaced in a manner that will allow for application of a continuous chemical barrier. Rod holes should not extend beneath the top of the footings.

A trench need not be wider than 6 inches. Rod from the base of a shallow trench to the top of the footings. Low pressure spray may be used to treat soil which will be replaced in the trench. Mix the emulsion with the soil as it is being replaced in the trench. Cover the treated soil with a layer of untreated soil.

Hollow Masonry Units of the Foundation

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RETREATMENT RESTRICTIONS

Retreatment for subterranean termites shall only be made when there is evidence of active termite infestation subsequent to the initial treatment, or there has been a mechanical break in the chemical barrier applied to the soil.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Prohibitions

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Open dumping is prohibited.

Storage

Store this product at temperatures above 50 F.

Pesticide Disposal

Pesticide spray mixture or residue that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

Container Disposal

For less than 30 gallons, triple rinse and offer for recycling, reconditioning, or disposal in approved landfill, or bury in a safe place. For 30 gallons or larger, triple rinse and offer for reconditioning OR triple rinse and offer for recycling, reconditioning or disposal in an approved landfill, or bury in a safe place.
