STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

CALL A PHYSICIAN OR POISON CONTROL CENTER IMMEDIATELY

If swallowed: Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger or blunt object. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled: Remove to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if necessary.

If on skin: Wash with mild soap and water.

If in eyes: Flush with plenty of water for 15 minutes.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: This product contains endosulfan which is a central nervous system stimulant and may cause convulsions. There is no specific antidote. Barbituric acid derivatives may be used in treatment
