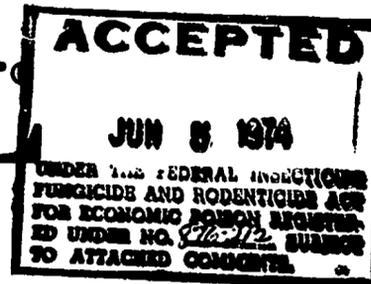
CONTAINER DISPOSAL

MIXING DIRECTIONS

Mix with water by agitation or by circulating the mixture through spray pump and back into the tank. A proper water mixture will have the appearance of a milky emulsion with no free oil on the surface. Agitate before use until a uniform milky emulsion is formed.

If a precipitate deposits in cold weather, warm gently with agitation until redissolved before using.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For ground application, apply using 100 gallons of water per acre. For aerial application, use 3 to 10 gallons of water per acre.
