Your submissions dated September 6, 1984

The labels referred to above, submitted in connection with registrations under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, are acceptable provided the following revisions are made prior to release for shipment under the amended labeling:

1. Revise the "If Swallowed" advice by deleting "Repeat until vomit fluid is clear" since this only increases the chance of the aspiration pneumonia complication. We recommend that you also delete this same phrase from the Gold Crest C-100 end use product (EPA Reg. No. 876-63) for the same reason.
2. Delete "or spray mist" from the Hazards to Humans section since this is not an end use product with spray mist uses.
3. The Hazards to Humans section statement "In case of contact, wash skin with soap and water or flush eyes with water for 15 minutes and get medical attention." could be interpreted to mean that if material accidentally gets on skin then the user should seek medical attention. Is this your intention? Such a recommendation is not presented in the "If on Skin" advice found in the Statement of Practical Treatment.
4. Revise the respirator advice to reflect the current names of the regulating agencies involved: "... and a pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mine Safety and Health Administration (MSHA) and by the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) for protection against chlordane".

5. Revise the Environmental Hazards text to read as follows:

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Do not discharge effluent containing this active ingredient into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

6. Add the following to the second paragraph of the Directions for Use:

"Repackagers using this product are responsible for obtaining EPA registration for their products."

Submit five (5) copies of the finished labels bearing the above revisions prior to release for shipment under the amended labeling. A stamped copy of the labeling for each of the subject products is enclosed for your records.

Please note that it is not necessary to include a Conditional Registration Agreement form when submitting such label update amendments.



1. Revise the "If Swallowed" advice by deleting "Repeat until vomit fluid is clear" since this only increases the chance of the aspiration pneumonia complication. We recommend that you also delete this same phrase from the Gold Crest C-100 end use product (EPA Reg. No. 876-63) for the same reason.
2. Delete "or spray mist" from the Hazards to Humans section since this is not an end use product with spray mist uses.
3. The Hazards to Humans section statement "In case of contact, wash skin with soap and water or flush eyes with water for 15 minutes and get medical attention." could be interpreted to mean that if material accidentally gets on skin then the user should seek medical attention. 
