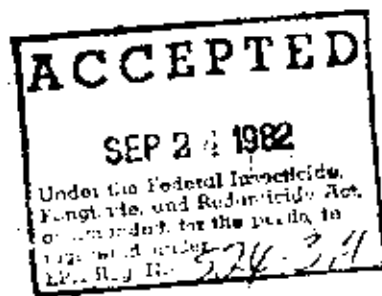


PROPOSED BRONCO® LABEL CHANGES

Note to Reviewer:

A marked label is to be used in conjunction with the attached text describing the proposed label changes. The code number on the label indicating location of a change corresponds to the same number in the text specifying the proposed label amendment.

These proposed Bronco® label changes do not constitute new or expanded uses for the products involved. The proposed table (c.f., label change (6)) indicating weed control or reduced competition merely provides a summary of information presently found in the label. The proposed recommendation (c.f., label change (11)) for use of additional amounts of Roundup® and Lasso® with Bronco does not exceed presently approved tank mix recommendations found on the Roundup and Lasso labels.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

1) PROHIBITIONS

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

2) PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide spray mixture, or residue that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

BANVEL CST is a specially formulated product for controlling undesirable trees and their sprouts in forest and non-forest areas such as along fence rows, drainage ditch banks and rights-of-way. This product requires no dilution or mixing and can be applied directly to freshly cut surfaces of trees such as:

alder	basswood	cottonwood	gum	maple	sassafras	sweetgum
ash	birch	dogwood	hawthorn	oak	serviceberry	sycamore
aspen	cedar	elm	hickory	persimmon	sourwood	willow
	cherry	fir	hornbeam	hoplar	sumac	

IMPORTANT

Do not contaminate irrigation ditches or water used for domestic purposes.

Do not apply to areas where the possible downward movement into the soil or surface washing may cause contact of BANVEL CST with the roots of desirable plants. Desirable plants, such as trees and shrubs, may also be affected by root uptake of herbicide from excretion by the roots of nearby treated trees. Therefore, do not use BANVEL CST close to desirable plants unless possible injury can be tolerated.

Do not apply using equipment which may cause spray drift onto sensitive crops or other desirable broadleaf plants. Use very low pressure or gravity flow equipment only.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

TREE INJECTION TREATMENTS: Injector cuts must penetrate the bark and the sapwood, and should be made completely around tree trunk with intervals of 1 to 2 inches between cut edges. An amount of 1 milliliter of BANVEL CST should be applied to each cut.

FRUIT or GIRDLE TREATMENTS: Make a continuous cut or a series of overlapping cuts using an axe to girdle tree trunk. Spray or paint cut surface with the BANVEL CST.

STUMP TREATMENTS: Spray or paint freshly cut surface with the BANVEL CST. The area adjacent to the bark should be thoroughly wet.
