



DETERGENT — CLEANING DIRECTIONS

A Low Phosphate, non-staining, non-flammable, Germicidal-Detergent.

GENERAL CLEANING: DISINFECTING:

Dilute ACTION, 2 oz. to one (1) gallon with water. Clean surface with wet cloth or mop, rinse cloth or mop in solution, wring out, wipe wet surface as dry as possible, allow to air dry.

DAMP-MOP & DAMP-CLOTH DUSTING:

Dilute ACTION, 2 oz. to 3½ gallons with water, wet mop or cloth in solution and wring out dry as possible. Wipe surface free of dust and dirt, and allow to air dry. When solution becomes dirty, make a fresh solution.

This method controls dust and reduces the hazard of cross-infection via environmental surfaces by sanitizing.

ACTION when diluted according to the above directions is harmless to walls, floors, toilet seats, wash basins, any hard surface not harmed by soap and water.

WARNING: CONCENTRATE

DISINFECTING — SANITIZING DIRECTIONS

ACTION is a disinfectant detergent fungicide deodorant, designed for controlling hazard of cross infection via environmental surfaces in Hospitals, Nursing Homes, Schools, Industries, etc. where housekeeping will be of prime importance. Hard surface sanitizing can help in this control. ACTION provides you with the needed assurance, when used as directed.

Solution	Dilution
#1. Disinfecting	2 oz. per one gal.
#2. Sanitizing	2 oz. per 3½ gal.
#1. As a disinfecting solution, ACTION will be effective against Pseudomonas aeruginosa PRD-10, and has been substantiated by the A.O.A.C. Use Dilution Test.	
ACTION is fungicidal against pathogenic fungi at this dilution. For heavy soil or organic matter, pre-clean surface first.	
#2. As a Sanitizing Solution, ACTION is an effective sanitizer, when used on previously cleaned hard surfaces.	

#2. Food Processing and Food Contact Items:
All equipment must be previously cleaned. Use the Sanitizing Solution as the final rinse, allow to air dry, (do not wipe dry). The equipment that has been sanitized does not require rinsing before re-use.

ACTION: fulfills the criteria of Appendix F, the Grade A Pasturized Milk Ordinance 1965 recommendations of the United States Public Health Service, in water up to 500 p.p.m. hardness calculated as CaCO₃, when tested by the A.O.A.C. Germicidal and Detergent Sanitizer Official Method.
