

DEODORANT DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Deodorant: To remove smoke and stale air odors in patients' rooms, restrooms, locker rooms, auditoriums, and meeting rooms, spray the air for a few seconds using a hand sprayer containing Germotox diluted with an equal part of water. If the odors are persistent, spraying from a Pioneer Mist Maker, in accordance with its label directions, is recommended.

To deodorize surfaces such as wrestling mats, athletic equipment and lockers, spray the surfaces for a few seconds using a hand sprayer containing Germotox diluted with an equal part of water. This treatment is also recommended for deodorizing soiled bed linen before it is removed from the bed in areas such as nursing homes.

To provide athletic uniforms with residual bacteriostatic activity against odor-causing microorganisms under conditions of wet contamination, add one cup of Germotox per 100 pounds of dry laundry to the final rinse cycle used in commercial laundry operations.

Germotox is USDA accepted for use in federally inspected meat and poultry plants. On any treated food contact surface, rinse with potable water, thoroughly.

Disinfectant: To disinfect hard, non-porous surfaces (such as tables, floors, walls, toilet seats, bedpans, washbasins, shower stalls, benches, bath mats, wrestling mats), wash visible soil from the surface; then apply Germotox undiluted with a mop, cloth, sponge or mechanical sprayer so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes; then rinse with clear water and wipe dry.

To disinfect urinals wash visible soil from surface; then swab entire urinal thoroughly, especially under rims, with undiluted Germotox. Let stand 10 minutes and flush.

Fungicide: To control pathogenic fungi on hard non-porous surface (such as shower room and locker room floors, benches and bath mats), wash visible soil from surface; then apply Germotox undiluted with a mop, cloth, sponge or mechanical sprayer so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly. Let air dry.

Mildewstat: To control mold and mildew on hard, non-porous surfaces (such as bathroom tiles and shower room floors), wash visible soil from the surface; then apply Germotox undiluted with a mop, cloth, sponge or mechanical sprayer so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly. Let air dry. Repeat application every 7 days to control recurrence of growth.

Disinfectant: To disinfect hard, non-porous surfaces (such as tables, floors, walls, toilet seats, bedpans, washbasins, shower stalls, benches, bath mats, wrestling mats), wash surfaces free of the surface, then apply Germotox undiluted with a mop, cloth, sponge or mechanical sprayer, until wet. Surfaces thoroughly. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes, then rinse with clean water and wipe dry.

To disinfect urinals, wash urine from surface, then swab entire urinal thoroughly with undiluted Germotox. Let stand 10 minutes and flush.

Fungicide: To control mold growth on hard non-porous surface (such as shower room floors, washbasins, bedpans, shower stalls, benches, bath mats), wash visible soil from surface, then apply Germotox undiluted with a mop, cloth, sponge or mechanical sprayer so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly.

Mildewstat: To control mold and mildew on hard, non-porous surfaces (such as bathroom floors and walls, shower stalls, washbasins, shower stalls, benches, bath mats), wash visible soil from surface, then apply Germotox undiluted with a mop, cloth, sponge or mechanical sprayer so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly. Repeat application every 7 days to control recurrence of growth.



Deodorant: To remove smoke and stale air odors in patients' rooms, treatment locker rooms, auditoriums and waiting rooms, scrub the air for a few seconds using a hand sprayer containing Germotox diluted with an equal part of water. If odors are persistent, scrub the bed with Germotox diluted with an equal part of water. In accordance with its label directions, use Germotox as a disinfectant.

To deodorize surfaces such as wrestling mats, athletic equipment and uniforms, scrub the surface for a few seconds using a hand sprayer containing Germotox diluted with an equal part of water. This treatment is also recommended for deodorizing soiled linens which is removed from the bed in areas such as nursing homes.

To provide athletic uniforms with residual bacteriostatic activity against the living microorganisms under conditions of use contamination, add one cup of Germotox to 100 pounds of dry laundry to the final rinse cycle used in commercial laundry operations.

Germotox is USDA accepted for use in federally inspected meat and poultry plants. It may be used on treated food contact surface, rinse with potable water immediately.
