

DIRECTIONS

ACTION Germicidal Cleaner is a disinfectant, sanitizer, detergent, fungicide, deodorant, and virucide* designed for reducing hazards of cross-infection on environmental surfaces in hospitals, nursing homes, and schools. ACTION can be used as a:

Disinfectant

ACTION, at a 1 to 64 dilution (2 oz. to 1 gal. of water) is an effective disinfectant and germicide. For best results, mop or wipe floors, walls, sink tops, rest rooms, garbage pails, and other hard surfaces. At this dilution, ACTION demonstrates bactericidal activity against Staphylococcus aureus, Salmonella choleraesuis, and Pseudomonas aeruginosa.

Sanitizer-Deodorant

ACTION, at a 1 to 228 dilution (2.8 oz. to 5 gal. of water), is an effective sanitizer when used on previously cleaned, hard surfaces. ACTION is authorized for use, under USDA Consumer and Marketing Service Inspection programs for poultry, meat, rabbit and egg product plants, as a sanitizer for food processing equipment and food contact items. Clean equipment first, rinse with ACTION sanitizer solution, rinse again with drinkable water, and allow to air dry.

Fungicide

ACTION, at a 1 to 64 dilution (2 oz. to 1 gal. of water), is effective against Trichophyton interdigitale strain #640 (Athlete's foot).

Virucide:

ACTION, when used on environmental, inanimate hard surfaces at 2 oz. per gallon of water, is effective against influenza A₁ (the Hong Kong Flu virus), Adenovirus type 2 (a causative virus in respiratory diseases), Herpes Simplex (a member of the virus family that causes infectious mononucleosis), and Vaccinia (representative of the pox viruses) viruses.
