

DIRECTIONS

* # 2 ounces per gallon of water. Apply with sponge mop or by spray method Be certain surfaces are thoroughly wetted

For heavy soils, a pre cleaning step is recommended before using this product. Where Pseudomonas organisms are suspected, use 3 ounces per gallon of water.

If used on food contact items, limit the level of active quaternary to 200 ppm 4 ounces per 5 gallons of water).


