DIRECTIONS

Use 2 ounces per gallon of water. Apply with sponge, mop or by spray method. Be certain surfaces are thoroughly wetted.

For heavy soils, a pre cleaning step is recommended before using this product. Where Pseudomonas organisms are suspected, use 3 ounces per gallon of water.

If used on food contact items, limit the level of active quaternary to 200 ppm (1 ounce per 5 gallons of water).

WARNING:
