The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

- 1) Add to the directions for use ^{im}mediately under the heading in bold type: **Not to be used on aircraft with passengers and crew aboard.**
- 2) Revise the statement "After spraying is complete, turn on ventilation system and board aircraft with passengers." to "After spraying is complete, turn on ventilation system and ventilate for 15 minutes prior to boarding the aircraft with passengers."
- 3) Provide Just one heading "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" and create two subheadings under that heading.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Do not use in commercial areas. In the home, food contact surfaces and equipment should be cleaned with an effective cleaning compound followed by a pot wash. Remove exposed food before spraying. Remove children and pets before spraying.

Physical Hazards

DIRECTIONS FOR USE AIRCRAFT

To kill flying insects (mosquitoes, houseflies and gnats) in aircraft when aircraft is empty of passengers and on the ground. Before takeoff and after loading of all cargo is complete, close all ventilation openings. Stop ventilation for a period of 15 minutes. Spray all spaces within the aircraft. Spray 10 grams (1/2 ounce) of insecticide per button to spray. Move arm from side to side in a figure 8 pattern. When complete, turn on ventilation system and board aircraft. Remove all passengers, close all doors, hatches and windows. Spray insecticide as instructed above.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE IN BUILDINGS AND IN TENTAGE FOR INSECT CONTROL

To Kill Flying Insects (Mosquitoes, Houseflies, Gnats): Release 3 feet from any surface, holding dispenser about 1 foot from surface while spraying. Amount of spraying is ample for each 1000 cubic feet (1000 cu ft) of treated area closed for at least 30 minutes. Ventilate area when necessary.

To Kill Cockroaches: Contact as many insects as possible by thoroughly spraying all parts of the room suspected of harboring. Attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces and other areas of hiding.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage:	Store in cool area away from heat and sunlight.
Disposal:	Do not reuse empty container. Recycle container in several layers of newspaper.
