

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL (CONTAINERS ABOVE ONE GALLON)

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

DIRECTIONS

FOLIAGE SPRAY: Mix 1 tablespoonful ($\frac{1}{2}$ fl. oz.) of DX INSECT SPRAY in each gallon of water for a general insect spray on FLOWERS, SHADE TREES, and ORNAMENTALS around homes, Estates, Parks and Institutions. When insects appear, direct spray to hit as many as possible and to thoroughly cover all plant surfaces, particularly the undersides of leaves. Repeat at weekly intervals or as necessary.

LIST OF INSECTS CONTROLLED

Aphids, Hoppers, exposed Thrips, adult Japanese Beetle, and Mites such as European Red Mite, Two-spotted Spider Mite, and Clover Mite on FLOWERS, SHADE TREES, and ORNAMENTALS

Mealy Bug and Whitefly on potted and greenhouse plants
Rose Chalcid, Midge, and Slug on Roses

PATIO SPRAY: To reduce the annoyance of Mosquitoes and gnats on PATIOS around the home grounds and in other recreational areas, apply a solution of six tablespoonfuls (three fluid ounces) of DX INSECT SPRAY in each gallon of water. Use a fine mist to penetrate hiding and resting places such as grass, shrubs, and ornamentals. Treat as large an area as possible surrounding the patio or grounds to be kept mosquito and gnat free. Repeat application as necessary. Apply at the rate of two pints of DX INSECT SPRAY per acre. Do not spray patio surfaces.

APHICIDE and SPREADER-STICKER: DX INSECT SPRAY may be used in combination with Methoxychlor, Carbaryl or Carbamate Fungicides as an aphicide and a spreader sticker. Tank mix 1 tablespoonful ($\frac{1}{2}$ oz.) of DX per gallon of water with the normal concentrations of the pesticides.
