EC 5 HEPTACHLOR

An emulsifiable concentrate containing 5 pounds of heptachlor per gallon.

ACCEPTED

Keep container closed. DO NOT STORE OR USE NEAR HEAT OR OPEN FLAME.

Do not store with foodstuffs.

For use in the control of soil-inhabiting and surface-feeding insects in turf grass areas of GOLF COURSES, CEMETERIES, PARKS and HOME LAWNS and other non-crop areas of NURSERIES and HEDGEROWS.

DIRECTIONS

Mix thoroughly with water and agitate mixture while using to assure uniformity of spray. Apply the required amount of heptachlor in sufficient water to assure thorough, uniform coverage.

For best results apply after a rain or irrigate area before treatment. Wash or work chemical into top 2 to 3 inches of soil immediately after application for soil-inhabiting insects. For surface-feeding insects do not irrigate for several days; then wash insecticide off the grass into the soil.

For Japanese Beetle larvae, white grubs, white-fringed beetle grubs, European Chafer larvae, Asiatic Garden Beetle larvae, Green June Beetle larvae use 1 gallon of EC 5 Heptachlor per acre (3 fl. oz. per 1000 sq. ft.). Make application when insects first appear or in the spring or fall when ground is not frozen or soggy.

For Armyworm, wireworm, Cutworm and Sod webworm use 1 gallon of EC 5 Heptachlor per acre (3 fl. oz. per 1000 sq. ft.). Late afternoon or evening applications are best for Sod webworm and Cutworm.

Area control of Chiggers, Fleas and Ticks: Apply 3 pints of EC Heptachlor per acre as water base spray. Treat grass, turf and ornamentals. This application will also reduce mosquito annoyance. Repeat as necessary.

WARNING: May be Fatal if Swallowed!

Do not breathe vapor or spray mist.

Do not get on skin. In case of contact wash immediately with soap and water.

Do not contaminate feed or foodstuffs.

To protect fish and wildlife, do not contaminate streams, lakes or ponds with this material.

Keep children and pets off treated areas until insecticide has been washed off the grass by rain or sprinkling and grass is completely dry.
