

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS: CAUTION--May be harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid inhalation of vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. STORAGE: Store in cool area away from heat and open flame. Store in tightly closed, original container in a locked area away from children and domestic animals. For Disposal, replace cap, and securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

DIRECTIONS

Avoid using in bright hot sunshine. Do not use on cyclamen, lantana, maidenhair fern and nasturtium.

1. Shake gently before using.
2. Remove protective cap. Hold can upright, and point nozzle away from you.
3. Press button to spray.
4. Spray plants from a distance of 10 to 12 inches, spraying in short 1 or 2 second bursts.
5. FOR BEST RESULTS: Spraying should begin when insects first appear and should be repeated as needed.

GENERAL INFORMATION

This spray may be used on African Violets, Begonias, Camellias, Carnations, Chrysanthemum, English Ivy, Geraniums, Crassula, Kentia Palm, Roses, Rubber Plants, Snapdragons.

Kills the following sucking insects: leaf hoppers, certain aphids, spotted mites, white flies and mealy bugs when sprayed directly on the insects.
