

Plants should be handled with particular care. Avoid using in direct sunlight or during hottest daylight hours. Repeat when necessary. DO NOT spray cyclamen, lantana, or Maiden Hair fern.

MAY BE USED ON: Roses, Asters, Anemones, Lili-

PATIO SPRAY: To kill and repel flies, mosquitoes, and gnats outdoors, apply a general insecting into the air and around area to be used, when there is little or no wind.

Avoid contamination of feed, utensils, or food stuff. Do not siphon or immerse container. Do not store above 100 F. hood and if reach of water do not use near food or open flame.

SHAKE BEFORE USING

Remove cap, hold in upright position, about 2 feet from object to be sprayed, with opening in nozzle pointing in desired direction. Press button to release spray and spray directly on insects where possible.

FLYING HOUSEHOLD INSECTS: Flies, Gnat, Mosquitoes: Close doors and windows of room and remove pets, birds, and fish. Then proceed to spray all parts of room with sweeping circular motion. Hit insects directly with spray where possible. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. 1 1/2 oz. (30 ml) per 100 sq. ft.
