1. Insert "Diazinon" before its chemical name and place chemical name in square brackets. Diazinon is now an acceptable common name.
2. Delete second sentence under CARPET BEETLES. Closets and shelvings are not likely sites for carpet beetles.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE IN FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS

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FM 15
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USE IN FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS: Places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared or served.

FOOD AREAS - APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY. Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing) preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups). Serving areas (when food is exposed and facility is in operation also would be considered a food area).

Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using equipment capable of delivering a pin stream in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases, conduits, motor housings, junction or switch boxes, where Roaches, Ants and Waterbugs hide.

Prior to application de-energize electrical equipment. After application, allow time for oil to evaporate before starting motors or placing switches in "on" position.

APPLICATIONS OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS OTHER THAN AS A CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ARE NOT PERMITTED.

SERVING AREAS: Facilities where prepared foods are served, such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held.

Apply as a spot treatment to selective surfaces such as baseboards, under elements of construction into cracks and crevices. Avoid treating surfaces likely to be contacted by food. (Do not apply when facility is in operation or foods are exposed.)

NON-FOOD AREAS: Includes garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

Apply to baseboard areas, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, pallets and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE IN NON-FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS

Spray infested surfaces only until wet.

ROACHES, ANTS, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, CRICKETS: Spray thoroughly into all cracks and around baseboards. Also spray until wet, surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, etc. Spray other localized areas infested with these pests. Repeat treatment as required.

CARPET BEETLES: Make localized application to areas of the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks and under carpets where insects can be found. Treat crevices, cracks or closets and infested areas of shelvings. Repeat as necessary.

BROWN DOG TICKS: Thoroughly spray infested areas around baseboards, windows and door frames, wall cracks, sleeping quarters of household pets and localized areas of floors and floor coverings. Applications should be repeated as infestations warrant and as re-infestations occur. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Do not treat animals with this formulation.
