

DIRECTIONS

LIFT HINGED CAP. SQUEEZE TO DUST.

For control of common insects and diseases in the home garden, keep all plant surfaces thoroughly dusted throughout the growing season with weekly applications. The best time to apply is early morning or late afternoon.





DIRECTIONS

Please Read Entire Label Before Using.

For control of common insects and diseases in the home garden, keep all plant surfaces thoroughly covered throughout the growing season with weekly applications.

DUSTING: Material is ready for use and can be dusted from the sifter can or transferred to a dust gun. The best time to apply is early morning or late afternoon.

SPRAYING: Prepare a thin, smooth paste by mixing a little water with 6 to 8 tablespoonfuls of material. Add paste to water in sprayer to make one gallon. Mix thoroughly. Apply with sprayer designed for garden use. 1 lb. makes 10 gallons of spray. **AGITATE SPRAY WHILE USING.** Do not store mixed spray.
