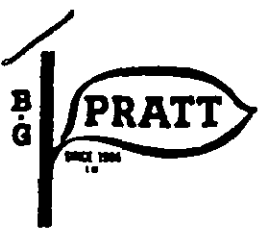

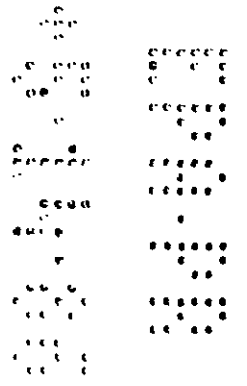

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS; CAUTION--Harmful if swallowed. Do not breathe vapors, dust, or spray mist. May cause irritation of eyes, nose, throat, or skin. Do not re-enter treated crop area prior to 24 hours after application.

RE-ENTRY AND ADDITIONAL APPLICATION RESTRICTIONS FOR AGRICULTURAL CROPS REQUIRING FARMWORKER HAND LABOR TASKS

Do not apply this product in such a manner as to directly, or through drift, expose workers or other persons. The area treated must be vacated by unprotected persons.

Protective clothing means at least a hat or other suitable head covering, a long-sleeved shirt and long-legged trousers or a coverall type garment (all closely woven fabric covering the body), shoes and socks.

Because certain states may require more restrictive re-entry intervals for various crops treated with this product, consult your State Department of Agriculture for further information.

Written or oral warnings must be given to workers who are expected to be in treated area or in an area about to be treated with this product. Instruct workers of the area or fields that must be vacated and not re-entered until the sprays have dried. Acquaint workers with the information appearing on this label under "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" and "Statement of Practical Treatment". When oral warnings are given, warnings shall be given in a language customarily understood by workers. Oral warnings must be given if there is reason to believe that written warnings cannot be understood by workers. Written warnings must include the following information: (1) Caution; (2) Area treated with Sulfur on (date of application); (3) Do not reenter treated crop area prior to 24 hours after application; (4) The information given under "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" and "Statement of Practical Treatment" that is appropriate in case of accidental exposure.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE ON AGRICULTURAL CROPS REQUIRING FARMWORKER HAND LABOR TASKS.

This material may be applied as a dust or spray for the control of such diseases as Black Spot on Roses; Powdery Mildew of Roses, Phlox, Zinnias, Sweet Peas and Lilacs; Rust on Snapdragons and Carnations; Brown Rot of Stone Fruits; Scab on Apples and Pears and to aid in keeping Red Spider Mites in check on evergreens.

Apply every week or ten days during the growing season, or more often during rainy weather. Cover all parts of the plant with a thin film of dust or spray. On stone fruits for Brown Rot, apply just as trees are coming into bloom, and after the petals fall, and at intervals of two weeks during the season. During the last month before harvest, dust lightly every week or ten days.

For scab on apples and pears, make weekly applications from the time new growth starts until 30 days after petal fall. Use more frequently during rainy periods. For Red Spider Mite, delay application on evergreens until the new growth has hardened.

DUSTING--Material is ready for use and is applied with a duster. Dust the plants lightly from two sides when the air is quiet.

SPRAYING--Add the required amount of material to water and stir thoroughly. Pour the mixture into the sprayer and keep agitated while spraying. In small sprayers, shake frequently for agitation.

DILUTIONS--Apples and pears, 3 to 4 pounds in 50 gallons of water -- 3 to 4 level tablespoonsful in each gallon of water.

Peaches, plums and prunes--also for red spider mites -- 2 to 3 pounds in 50 gallons of water -- 2 to 3 level tablespoonsful in each gallon of water.

Flowers and ornamentals -- 2 to 3 pounds in 50 gallons of water -- 2 to 3 level tablespoonsful in each gallon of water.

CAUTION: DO NOT USE SULFUR ON APPLE FOLIAGE WITHIN TWO WEEKS OF AN OIL SPRAY.
AVOID SPRAYING WHEN TEMPERATURE IS WARMER THAN 85°F.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in tightly closed, original container in a locked area away from children and domestic animals.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
