Turf and Ground Covers	Snails, slugs, sod webworms (lawn moths), armyworms, cutworms, millipedes, sowbugs (pillbugs)	2 oz. per gal. 1 1/2 gal. per 100 gal.	Water turf thoroughly before treating. Apply 1 gallon of spray mixture per 130 to 150 square feet of area treated. Soak debris under infested plants to kill snails and slugs excluded in such spots. Note: Snails and slugs stop feeding soon after treatment but complete kill may be delayed for 2 or 3 days.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Mix ZECTRAN Z-05 Insect Spray with water and apply as a spray to pest-infested ornamental plants and turf as specified in the USE RECOMMENDATIONS TABLE. Make the application using hand or power spray equipment or hose attached applicator that will provide thorough and uniform coverage of plants and turf. Re-treat as necessary.
