GREENHOUSE PESTS

For infestations of whiteflies or lignosus in the same period on chrysanthemums, coleus, geraniums, igeratum, petunia, aster, calendula, marigold, roses, zinnia and cary

Contact Spray--For whiteflies apply Plant Greenhouse Whitefly Spray at 1 pint per 100 gallons of water or 1 teaspoonful per gallon. Spray upper and lower surfaces of plant foliage to point of runoff. Spray in late afternoon and at night only, when the temperature ranges from 50 F. to 72 F. Repeat application weekly for four weeks or longer for control of adults, pupae and nymphs. Complete spray schedule on poinsettia before blooms form.

Where fewer applications are preferred, spray at the rate of 1 quart per 100 gallons of water or 2 teaspoonful per gallon. Repeat as necessary. Apply sprays as mentioned above.

Non—Thermal Applicators Close off greenhouse area to be treated for whitefly infestations. Direct mist first toward upper corners of the greenhouse, then apply evenly throughout the area. Keep nozzle at least 3 feet from plant foliage. Apply Pratt Greenhouse Whitefly Spray at the rate of 1 1/2 fluid ounces thoroughly mixed in 3 fluid ounces of methylene chloride per 10,000 cubic feet. This is equivalent of 1 gram of active ingredient per 1,000 cubic feet. Keep treated area closed off for at least 2 hours. Ventilate before re-entry. Apply at weekly intervals for at least 4 weeks. Applications should be made during the late afternoon or at night when the temperature range is 50 F. to 72 F.
