Pratt Insecticide Diazinon 2%
Dust for Military Use
EPA Registration No. 904-301
Your Letter Dated March 10, 1986

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. The wording and subsequent statement "Precaucion Al Usuario: Si usted . . ." is not necessary. This wording is normally used mainly for agricultural-use products where hand labor is required. We suggest that it be deleted unless you have justifiable reason to retain it.
2. The "Note To Physician" section should follow the "If In Eyes" section.
3. Please add a street address or P.O. Box after the company name on the front label.
4. Revise the Precautionary Statements sentence to read, "Do not breathe dust."
5. Because this product is being used as an indoor product only, the "Environmental Hazards" section should be deleted.
6. The heading should read "Physical or Chemical Hazards." An "s" has been added to Hazard.

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7. Delete the heading "Directions" which follows the "Storage and Disposal" section.
8. Delete the three paragraphs starting with the wording "Do not apply this product . . ." and ending with the paragraph which starts with "Written or oral warnings must . . ." This wording is used with agricultural-use products where hand labor is involved and where such products are either Toxicity Categories I or II.
9. We assume you have data to support the statement, "effective several weeks." If not, please delete this wording.
10. This is a dust product with no solvent in product. Therefore, delete the wording, "Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material has been taken internally."

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

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PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS: CAUTION--Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Do not breathe spray mist or vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not contaminate food or feed. Apply dust only to areas inaccessible to children and pets. Do not use in edible products area of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially processed. Do not use in service areas when food is exposed. Do not use on humans or household pets. Utensils such as teaspoons and cups used to measure pesticides should not be used for food products.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish and wildlife. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur or when weather conditions favor drift from treated areas. Cover bird baths and fish ponds. This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or to residues remaining on treated areas. Do not apply when honey bees are actively visiting the crop, or weeds blooming in the treatment area. Applications should be timed to provide the maximum possible interval between treatment and the next interval period of bee activity.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. STORAGE: Store in tightly closed, original container in a locked area away from children and domestic animals. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

DIRECTIONS

APPLY THIS PRODUCT ONLY AS SPECIFIED ON THIS LABEL - FOR USE BY TRAINED PERSONNEL ONLY.

Do not apply this product in such a manner as to directly, or through drift, expose workers or other persons. The area treated must be vacated by unprotected persons.

Do not enter treated areas without protective clothing. Protective clothing means at least a hat or other suitable head covering, a long-sleeved shirt and long-legged trousers or a coverall type garment (all closely woven fabric covering the body), shoes and socks.

Written or oral warnings must be given to workers who are expected to be in treated area or in an area about to be treated with this product. Instruct workers of the area that must be vacated and not re-entered until after product has been applied. Acquaint workers with the information appearing on this label under "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" and "Statement of Practical Treatment". When oral warnings are given, warnings shall be given in a language customarily understood by workers. Oral warnings must be given if there is reason to believe that written warnings cannot be understood by workers. Written warnings must include the following information: 1) The name of this product; 2) Date of application; 3) The statement: "Do not enter without appropriate protective clothing."; 4) The information given under "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" and "Statement of Practical Treatment" that is appropriate in case of accidental exposure.

Apply dust to the interior of barracks and other buildings, paying particular attention to areas behind and beneath cabinets and sinks, and to cracks, crevices and other areas where cockroaches are likely to crawl or rest. Use a plunger, bulb or bellow duster to blow the dust into areas to be treated. Do not apply dust to areas where it would be unsightly or would be removed by routine cleanup operations. One application, unless removed, will remain effective several weeks or more. Re-apply as needed.
