**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

**IF IN EYES:** Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician.

**IF SWALLOWED:** Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solutions, or if these are not available drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

**IF INHALED:** Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Get medical attention.

**IF ON SKIN:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area with soap and water. Launder clothing before reusing.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS: DANGER—**Causes irreversible eye damage. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. May cause allergic skin reactions. Do not get in eyes. Avoid contact with skin and clothing. Keep children and pets out of treated areas until spray has dried or dust has settled. Do not contaminate food or feed. Wash hands thoroughly after handling. Food utensils, such as tablespoons, should not be used for food after use with this product.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes, and potholes). Drift and runoff from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

**PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS**

Avoid contact with open flame.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Wear goggles or face shield when handling. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and separately launder clothing before reuse.

Mixer/loaders when mixing and loading this product must wear a long sleeved shirt and long pants or a coverall that covers all parts of the body except the head, hands and feet. Wear chemical resistant gloves, goggles or a face shield and a chemically resistant apron.

Fieldworkers and harvesters must wear chemical resistant gloves. Leather or fabric gloves are not acceptable.

**AFTER WORK:** Take off all clothes and shoes. Shower using soap and water. Do not wear contaminated clothing. Wash protective clothing and equipment with soap and water after each use. Personal clothing worn during use must be laundered separately from household articles. Clothing and protective equipment heavily contaminated or drenched with captan must be destroyed according to state and local regulations.

A dust mask must be worn when mixing and loading this product.

During application only, from a tractor with a completely enclosed cab or from an aircraft with an enclosed cockpit a long sleeved shirt and long legged pants must be worn. Chemically resistant gloves must be available in the cab or cockpit and worn while exiting.

**STORAGE & DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Store in tightly closed, original container in a locked area away from children and domestic animals.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

**DIRECTIONS**

Do not allow persons to enter treated areas within 4 days following application unless a long-sleeved shirt and long pants or a coverall that covers all parts of the body except the head, hands and feet and chemically resistant gloves are worn.

**TURF, LAWN**

**Brown Patch, Leaf Spot, Damp-Off, Root Rot:** 14 lbs. per 100 gals. of water. Apply 10 gals. to each 1,000 sq. ft. of turf. Apply prior to infection. Repeat at 7-10 day intervals if necessary. Do not graze treated areas. Do not feed clippings to livestock.

**ORNAMENTALS, ROSES: Black Spot CARNATIONS: Rust and Leaf Spot CHRYSANTHEMUMS: Flower Blight:** 14 lbs. per 100 gals. of water. Apply at first sign of disease, cover upper and lower leaf surfaces thoroughly. Repeat every 7-10 days.

**SOIL AND GREENHOUSE BENCH TREATMENTS:**

**CAUTION—**Only the applicator is permitted to be in the greenhouse during application of captan. Open vents to greenhouse during application and for at least 1 hour after application.

Workers planting in captan-treated soil in greenhouses must wear chemical resistant gloves.

Preplanting for Damp-Off and Root Rot Diseases on Seedlings or Transplants of Roses (and other Shrubs and Trees), Many Flowers and Lawn Seedbeds: Apply as a dust at 2 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. or spray at 14 lbs. per 100 gals. of water, using 15 gals. to each 1,000 sq. ft. Cultivate into upper 3-4 inches of soil before planting.
