On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act. Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is reregistered in accordance with the requirements of FIFRA.

A copy of the stamped accepted label is enclosed. When this label is printed for distribution, incorporate the changes listed below.

1. Make sure that the type sizes used on printed labels for the signal word ("**DANGER**") and the words "**Keep out of reach of children**" (KOOROC) conform to or exceed the sizes required by regulation in 40 CFR §156.60(b)(1) (e.g., 18-point type for signal word, 12-point for KOOROC if center panel of the label is larger than 30 square inches). The size of the box in which the text appears could be increased as necessary to accommodate the required type sizes and to allow larger type to be used for the "**FIRST AID**" statements.

2. On the label for the 10-lb package size (and any other package size exceeding 5 lbs), change the "**PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)**" text to read as shown below.

### **PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)**

Applicators and other handlers must wear:

- long-sleeved shirt and long pants
- cotton gloves
- shoes plus socks
- dust/mist filtering respirator (NIOSH/MSHA approval number prefix TC-21C), or a NIOSH approved respirator with an N, P, R, or HE filter

Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning and maintaining PPE. If there are no such instructions, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.

3. On the label for the 10-lb, plastic pail container, change the "**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**" to read as shown below.

### **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal...

**Pesticide Storage:** Store only in original labeled container in a cool, dry inaccessible to children, pets, and domestic animals.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spilled bait, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA regional Office for guidance.

**Container Disposal:** Triple-rinse container. Then puncture container and offer it for recycling or disposal in a sanitary landfill. If allowed by State and local authorities, container may be disposed of by burning. If container is burned, stay out of smoke. Do not reuse container.

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Along with items submitted on February 8, 2006, the additional information included in your submission of May 11, 2006, is sufficient to meet the storage stability data requirement for this product. The product chemist who reviewed those items notes, however, that the study was not run according to "Good Laboratory Practice" (GLP) standards. Consequently, the reviewer recommends that a new GLP storage stability be conducted, in accordance with 40 CFR §160.135(a) and OPPTS Guideline 830.6317, as EPA may require MRID No. 467677-01 to be replaced in the future.

Submit two copies each of final printed labels for the 1-lb and 10-lb packages for this product.

This product is registered for use only for manual, subterranean applications to control *Geomys* spp. and *Thomomys* spp. pocket gophers. Note the statements in our letter of May 23, 2003, regarding the States where such organisms occur. Those are the only states in which this product may be used and, therefore, the only ones in which it should be sold.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
